Earthcycle [™] Sustainable Packaging Solution Finalist in Fruit Attraction Innovation Hub Awards Earthcycle Blueberry Packaging competing in Sustainability and Commitment Actions category

HANTSPORT, NS (Sept 28th, 2023) – CKF Inc., a prominent global leader specializing in the design and North American manufacturing of sustainable packaging solutions, proudly announces its status as one of the five distinguished finalists for the Fruit Attraction Innovation Hub Award for Sustainability and Commitment. CKF's submission for consideration is the EC 652, a successful 18 oz top-seal blueberry punnet that has been increasingly making its presence felt in major North American big-box retailers.

Shannon Boase, Senior Director of New Market Development, expresses the company's elation: "We are honored to receive recognition from our industry peers worldwide, acknowledging our groundbreaking Earthcycle material innovation, and, in particular, our innovative blueberry packaging."

The blueberry packaging in question is not only certified as home compostable and recyclable but also bears the FSC[®] certification (FSC[®] C145472). In April 2023, a pivotal supply chain and retail trial was conducted in collaboration with Costco Canada and The Fruitist. Based on positive feedback from consumers and its solid performance within the supply chain, the packaging was subsequently rolled out in July. It reached a wider network of blueberry packers, becoming readily available throughout Canada and select stores in the US Pacific Northwest in partnership with Townsend Farms.

The new Earthcycle-branded EC 652 is designed as an 18 oz top-seal blueberry punnet, engineered to seamlessly integrate into automated packing lines equipped with existing top-seal tooling. In the process of bringing this innovative package to market, CKF approached the challenge with a holistic perspective, collaborating closely with key players throughout the supply chain. Shannon Boase highlights this approach: "We engaged in partnerships with top-seal, denester, and flexible film companies, all with the shared objective of matching or even surpassing PET pack speeds using Earthcycle punnets. This value-added collaboration with our packing clients has yielded positive outcomes, enabling us to meet our pack speed objectives."

CKF will be showcasing the EC 652, alongside its comprehensive range of Earthcycle packaging solutions for produce, at the upcoming Fruit Attraction event in Madrid, at Booth 8B07B.
